



Notes:

1. Mount a 200mm x 60mm blank between centres.
2. Turn blank down to 55mm diameter, with a chucking spigot at what will be the doll's head end.
3. Mount in chuck. Mark bottom/plug, allowing enough distance for parting off.
4. Shape the skirt.
5. Shape the bottom/plug and part off.
6. Hollow out the rattle chamber and fit bottom/plug.
7. Add rattle material, and glue bottom/plug into place.
8. Finish shaping the rest of the doll, slightly hollowing the base.
9. Sand, apply your preferred finish and part off.
10. Decorate and final finish.
11. Rattle material can be popping corn, rice, dried peas etc.
12. Wood and finishes used should be 'food safe'.
