Notes:

- 1. Mount a 200mm x 60mm blank between centres
- Turn blank down to 55mm diameter, with a chucking spigot at what will be the doll's head end.
- Mount in chuck. Mark bottom/plug, allowing enough distance for parting off.
- 4. Shape the skirt.
- Shape the bottom/plug and part off
- Hollow out the rattle chamber and fit bottom/plug.
- Add rattle material, and glue bottom/plug into place
- Finish shaping the rest of the doll, slightly hollowing the base.
- Sand, apply your preferred finish and part off.
- 10. Decorate and final finish.
- 11. Rattle material can be popping corn, rice, dried peas etc.
- 12. Wood and finishes used should be 'food safe'.
